By clicking (yes) you agree to the following. The owner or person dropping off pet will be required to show and allow their driver license's to be scanned and stored in our database.

This establishment agrees to exercise due and responsible care and to keep the premises sanitary and properly enclosed. Your pet will be fed, watered, regularly and housed in safe, clean quarters.

The services we provide are done so without liability for loss or damage from disease, death, running away, theft or fire and from injury or damage done by your pet to people, other animals or property, or other unavoidable causes. Due diligence and care will be exercised. This establishment doesn't have 24 hour staff.

Should any pet become ill or need medical attention, we reserve the right to administer aid and to render care by your local designated veterinarian if available. Any expenses incurred, being reasonable in amount, shall be paid promptly by the owner to the veterinarian office.

No pet will be released until all charges are paid in full or other arrangements satisfactory to our kennel by the owner.

The customer agrees to notify us in advance if there are any changes in the pets pick up date.

If a pet is to stay 10 days or more prepayment maybe required for at least 10 days.

If the pet is picked up before or after business hours for that day there will be a \$75.00 additional charge plus the next day

The owner of this pet or his agent agrees to pay reasonable legal fees and costs incurred by the kennel in the collections of outstanding bills.

Our services are offered with the expectation of prompt payment. Failure to pay constitutes Theft of Service. Texas Penal code section 31.04, which is a state jail felony. The pet will be considered abandon five (5) days after original pickup date, and will be turned over to animal control, with no legal liabilities to Magnolia Kennel or any staff member.
